	Henry R. Kranzler, M.D. is Director of the Center for Studies of Addiction at the University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Kranzler's research, which focuses on the genetics and pharmacological treatment of substance dependence, has been continuously supported since 1987 by grants from the U.S. National Institutes of Health. He has authored or co-authored more than 500 journal articles, book chapters, and books, is a member of the editorial board of five peer-review journals and is the Editor of <i>Alcoholism: Clinical and Experimental Research</i> . His work currently focuses on the molecular genetics of substance dependence and the personalized treatment of alcohol, opioid, and nicotine use disorders using a pharmacogenetic approach.
